

Dress Code

All students in preschool through eighth grade attending GCCS are expected to dress in the proper standard school uniform. It is the parent/guardian's responsibility to ensure compliance with the dress code. All students who attend GCCS must dress in accordance with the dress code.

The clothing may not be altered in a manner that includes but is not limited to slits and shredded hems. The standard school clothing shall be:

Dress Code for Students

- Maroon or white collared shirts or GCCS school shirt only. All other shirts are prohibited.
- Solid black, blue, or khaki-colored slacks, shorts, jumpers, skorts, capris and/or skirts only. All other colors are prohibited, NO JEANS or denim of any sort.
- Solid black, blue, maroon, white, or khaki-colored jackets/sweaters only. All other colors are prohibited.
- When average temperature reaches 80 degrees, no sweatshirts (with or without hoods), jackets, are allowed.
- Baggy or oversized clothing is unacceptable. Clothing may not be more than one size too large, to allow for one-year's growth. No sagging of clothing is allowed. Belt must be worn around the waist.
- Undershirts must be black or white and must be tucked in under uniform shirt.
- Shorts and skirts should be no more than 2 inches above the knee.
- No sweatpants, leggings, spandex, or jeggings.
- The only type of headgear permitted will be a hat or beanie, which may be worn to and from school only (outside of buildings/classrooms). No hoods can be worn inside the buildings/classrooms.
- For safety reasons, students are encouraged to wear covered shoes. Flip-flops, slippers, or bare feet are unacceptable.
- Piercings--No piercings are allowed other than ear lobes.
- Color of hair must be natural. If student comes to school with other than their natural hair color, student will have three days to get hair back to natural color. If this does not occur, student will spend each day in Success Academy until hair is at its natural color. Hair style or length should not obstruct vision.
- Cosmetics will not be allowed at school and will be confiscated.

Students not dressed in accordance with the dress code will not be permitted in class until they are in compliance (Administrative Discretion). Designated staff will notify the student's parent/guardian and inform him/her of the violation.
